Norman, a cognitive psychologist, outlines the elements of effective user-centered design, which include making the inner workings of devices visible, exploiting natural function, controlling relationships, and using constraints successfully. Through both fable and anecdote, Norman illustrates <u>forcing functions</u> and how bad design can exacerbate the consequences of human error. This classic text is a valuable introduction to the role of design in patient safety.
