This memoir shares the story of Sorrel King's crusade to make medical care safer. <u>Sorrel King</u> is the mother of Josie King, who died tragically in 2001 at age 18 months because of medical errors during a hospitalization at Johns Hopkins Hospital. She has subsequently become one of the nation's foremost patient advocates for safety, forming an influential foundation (the <u>Josie King Foundation</u>) and partnering with Johns Hopkins to promote the field of patient safety around the world.
