

Understanding the attitudes of hospital pharmacists to reporting medication incidents: a qualitative study.

This qualitative study identified a culture of low expectations among hospital pharmacists with regard to [voluntary error reporting systems](#). Pharmacists admitted that systems were underused but ascribed this to the high prevalence of medication errors and the low likelihood of receiving feedback after reporting an error.
