Incomplete <u>handoffs</u> and poor communication regarding key clinical information may lead to adverse events or <u>missed or delayed diagnoses</u>. Emergency medicine clinicians failed to communicate significant vital sign abnormalities in the majority of patients being handed off at the time of shift change.
