

## **Advancing the future of patient safety in oncology: implications of patient safety education on cancer care delivery.**

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A seminal [report](#) described the lack of formal curricula for patient safety in medical education as an unmet need. This commentary reviews a 1-day session that presented a core [curriculum](#) in patient safety to third-year medical students, half of whom declared at the program onset that they had no awareness of systems approaches to enhance safety. The session employed [simulation](#), [root cause analysis](#), and online modules as educational tactics. Participants reported feeling more comfort with [acting](#) on safety concerns after attending the session.
