Organizations with robust safety culture, as measured by AHRQ's <u>Hospital Survey on Patient Safety</u> <u>Culture</u>, have improved <u>objective measures of safety</u>. Researchers compared the AHRQ survey to a factorial survey examining safety behavior among employees in a radiotherapy department. The two surveys yielded similar results, while the factorial survey added that staff were more likely to <u>report safety</u> concerns if they caused patient harm.
