This survey study of nurses across four ambulatory surgical wards in Ohio found that nursing managers' <a href="Leadership styles"><u>leadership styles</u></a> and some aspects of the <u>safety climate</u> (such as teamwork and organizational learning) were associated with how willing nurses are to report medication errors.
