Scheduling overlapping procedures is <u>perceived</u> as risky, despite lack of robust <u>evidence</u> regarding its impact on patient safety. This commentary explains that the practice is primarily detrimental to the physician–patient relationship and that building trust is a key strategy to manage this concern. The authors suggest transparency with patients about <u>scheduling</u> practices and hospital oversight to ensure accountability would assist in establishing the trust in <u>overlapping</u> surgeries.
