

Diagnostic errors: impact of an educational intervention on pediatric primary care.

The [National Academy of Medicine](#) has emphasized that [diagnostic errors](#) lead to substantial [morbidity and mortality](#). This quasi-experimental study showed that after an educational intervention, diagnostic error knowledge increased among pediatric primary care providers and there was a trend toward a reduction in patients returning with the same chief complaint within 14 days.
