The <u>National Academy of Medicine</u> has emphasized that <u>diagnostic errors</u> lead to substantial <u>morbidity and mortality</u>. This quasi-experimental study showed that after an educational intervention, diagnostic error knowledge increased among pediatric primary care providers and there was a trend toward a reduction in patients returning with the same chief complaint within 14 days. A <u>Patient Safety Primer</u> summarizes challenges in reducing diagnostic errors.
