

Realizing e-prescribing's potential to reduce outpatient psychiatric medication errors.

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Electronic prescribing is associated with improvements in medication safety, but it can also introduce <u>problems</u> unique to information technology use. This commentary discusses this issue in the context of <u>reducing errors</u> in outpatient psychiatry medication administration. The authors recommend increasing e-prescribing implementation, enhancing <u>usability</u>, and improving interoperability between hospital and retail pharmacy systems to achieve progress.
