Addressing the <u>opioid epidemic</u> has necessitated <u>new approaches</u> to prevent opioid misuse. This announcement describes new FDA requirements regarding <u>labeling changes</u> for prescription <u>cough and</u> <u>cold medicines</u> containing codeine or hydrocodone in pediatric patients.
