<u>Diagnostic errors</u> and delays may occur when patients fail to disclose medically relevant information. This study analyzed online survey responses from 4510 patients and found that about 70% reported not disclosing information. Disagreement with a clinician's recommendation or failure to <u>understand</u> a clinician's instructions were common. Patients most often did not disclose because they feared judgment from the clinician or felt embarrassed.
