

The impact of post-fall huddles on repeat fall rates and perceptions of safety culture: a quasi-experimental evaluation of a patient safety demonstration project

Huddles are a patient safety tool used by healthcare teams to communicate changes in patient care. This longitudinal study examined the impact of post-fall huddles on inpatient [fall](#) rates and found that huddles may reduce the risk of repeat falls and improve perceived [safety culture](#) around fall risk reduction.
