

The effect of implementing bar-code medication administration in an emergency department on medication administration errors and nursing satisfaction.

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<u>Barcoding</u> of medications is one approach to improving medication administration <u>safety</u>. In this study, direct observation was used to compare medication error rates and <u>nursing</u> satisfaction before and after implementation of bar-code medication administration in a community hospital emergency department. Three months after its implementation, the medication administration error rate significantly decreased by 74.2% and nursing satisfaction increased.
