The burden of the COVID-19 <u>pandemic</u> has placed healthcare workers at higher risk for <u>poor</u> mental health outcomes. This survey of doctors, nurses, and other healthcare staff working in intensive care units (ICUs) identified significant rates of probable mental health disorders and thoughts of self-harm. These findings reinforce the need to support the <u>emotional well-being</u> of healthcare workers during this crisis.
