

Implicit racial/ethnic bias among health care professionals and its influence on health care outcomes: a systematic review.

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Implicit biases against people of color can affect quality of care including <u>diagnostic delay</u>, <u>hospital-acquired infections</u>, and obstetric <u>morbidity</u> and <u>mortality</u>. This review summarizes the impact of healthcare providers' racial and ethnic implicit biases on health outcomes. The authors also provide recommendations for future research.
