Medication-assisted treatment (MAT) is <u>increasingly</u> used to treat <u>opioid use disorder</u> (OUD). This study found that providers or practices with higher quality measure scores of MAT continuity (percentage of patients with OUD who had at least 180 days of continuous treatment) had a lower risk of opioid-related adverse events among their patients.
