

Nurse well-being: a concept analysis.

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Clinician <u>well-being</u> has important implications for patient safety and quality of healthcare delivery. In this study, researchers used a concept analysis to identify attributes of nurse well-being at the individual level (e.g., satisfaction, compassion) and <u>organizational/community level</u> (e.g., <u>teamwork</u>, pride in work). These findings can support the development of a standardized definition of nurse well-being to guide future research and policy considerations around well-being and <u>burnout</u>.
