Clinicians involved in adverse events may experience feelings of guilt, shame, and inadequacy; this is referred to as "<u>second victim</u>" phenomenon. In this study of pediatric surgeons and surgical trainees, 84% experienced a poor patient outcome. Responses to the adverse event varied by level of experience (e.g., resident, attending), gender, and age.
