

## **Factors associated with potentially harmful medication prescribing in nursing homes: a scoping review.**

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Despite [evidence](#) of associated adverse events, older adults in nursing homes are [frequently](#) prescribed potentially inappropriate medications (PIM). This review sought to identify facility and prescriber characteristics associated with PIM prescribing. Antipsychotic medications were the focus of more than half of included studies, and were associated with low registered nurse staffing, for-profit facility status, and younger men. No study investigated prescriber characteristics.
