People with disabilities face barriers to safe, equitable care such as inaccessible <u>equipment</u> and facilities or provider bias. In this study, primary care and specialist physicians described challenges with caring for patients with disabilities. Many expressed explicit biases such as reluctance to care for people with disabilities, invest in accessible equipment, or obtain continuing <u>education</u> to provide appropriate care.
