

Exploring nursing-sensitive events in home healthcare: a national multicenter cohort study using a trigger tool.

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<u>Nurse-sensitive</u> outcomes are important indicators of <u>nursing safety</u>. In this retrospective study of 600 patient records from ten Swedish home healthcare organizations, researchers found that 74% of patient safety incidents were classified as nursing-sensitive and that the majority of those events were preventable. The most common types of nursing-sensitive events were <u>falls</u>, pressure injuries, <u>healthcare-associated infections</u>, and incidents related to medication management.
