

Preventable hospital admissions related to medication (HARM): cost analysis of the HARM study.

Adverse drug events (ADE) in the outpatient setting can result in hospital <u>admission</u> and are largely <u>preventable</u>. This study used data from the earlier <u>Hospital Admissions Related to Medication</u> (HARM) study to estimate the cost (medical cost to the health system and loss of patient productivity) of each ADE-related hospital admission. The expense of each ADE can be significant, suggesting programs to reduce ADE may be cost-neutral or <u>cost-saving</u>.
