In the <u>United States</u>, women and birthing people of color experience disproportionately high rates of mortality and <u>severe maternal morbidity</u> (SMM). Researchers analyzed two years of incident reports (IR) to ascertain potential system issues contributing to SMM and racial/ethnic disparities at one hospital. <u>Non-Hispanic Black</u> individuals were over-represented in IRs, but there were no statistically significant differences in harm level.
