Women of color report receiving <u>substandard</u> care due to provider and <u>structural racism</u>. This study shares the pregnancy and birth <u>experiences</u> of women of color. The women reported providers "packaged" health information which reduced their ability and autonomy to make informed decisions for themselves and their children.
