Bias against women is, unfortunately, common in healthcare, which can result in <u>undertreatment</u>. This study analyzed emergency department discharge notes for more than 21,000 patients which showed that physicians and nurses are more likely to <u>doubt</u> women's pain <u>reports</u> and prescribe less <u>pain-relieving</u> medication compared to men with the same self-reported pain score.
