<u>Stress</u> among surgeons is common and may be <u>associated</u> with surgical errors. This study tracked surgeons' stress using body-worn sensors during the first 5 minutes of surgery to explore the association between stress and postoperative complications. Interestingly, increased stress during the first 5 minutes of surgery was associated with reduced major surgical complications. There was no association with intensive care unit stay or mortality.
